

Terms and Conditions of Freeflight Paragliding

- 1: Before tuition commences you must inform your Instructor of any injuries, which required hospital treatment within the last six months.
- 2: The minimum age is 16, if you are less than age of 18, written guardian authorization is required.
- 3: No alcohol or drugs may be consumed in the 12 hours preceding instruction or during instruction.
- 4: Evening before call 01273 628793 to see if flying is on, try and call after 5 pm please. Re booking is a simple task of calling 01273 628793. Office hours 10 am to 5 pm.
- 5: Confirmation of attendance and to find out if the flying is on for the day should be made between 6 pm and 7 pm only on the evening before. This will state when and where to meet, the contact number is 01273 628793. Failure to confirm and non- attendance will result in the loss of your days training and your money. Reason being Instructors and land has to be booked and paid for in advance.
- 6: A minimum of 48 hours is required to cancel a booking, this must be on 01273 628793 between office hours 10 am to 5 pm seven days a week.
- 7: Freeflight reserves the right without reason to cancel a students course or part course and refund monies proportionally for the outstanding period. Courses are valid for six months from date of payment with application form.
- 8: Freeflight operates May to September, there after by appointment only, weekends are as normal. The school over seas training operates mainly October to April.
- 9: Taster days and Courses are none refundable and none transferable and must be used within the allocated time from date of purchase.
- 10: Vouchers/ can be down loaded from the web site under "Applications" Vouchers are valid from the date of purchase for 6 months.
- 11: If you fail to turn up at the agreed date and time, but still want to book another day then a £70:00 fee will be charged for each session missed. To be paid in advance before any further booking will be taken.
- 12: Freeflight reserves the right to withhold a students license if they are deemed unsuitable or unsafe as pilots.
- 13: Boots that give good ankle and sole protection are to be worn while training is completed.
